Today's Celebrity Speaker

The featured speaker today is Chris Compton from Dallas.

Chris began playing bridge professionally in the ACBL at the age of 17. He is a World Grand Master and an ACBL Grand Life Master with over 23,000 masterpoints. After practicing law for ten years, Chris returned to professional bridge full time in 2007.

While representing the United States, Chris placed 4th in the 1986 World Open Pairs in Miami, Florida (at the age of 26), and again placed 4th in the 1998 World Open Pairs in Lille, France. He continues to represent the USA in international invitational events on a regular basis.

In the US, Chris won the National Swiss Team in Detroit in 2009 and the 1989 Reisinger Board-a-Match Teams at the Lancaster NABC and finished 2nd in both the 1986 and 2005 Vanderbilt Knockout Teams. Chris has at least three additional NABC 2nd place finishes and no less than six semi-final appearances in Vanderbilt and Spingold Knockout events.

Playing in a series of Bridge Pro Tour individuals during the year 2003, Chris won \$16,400 and remains the BPT all-time winning money leader. Chris enjoys playing high stakes rubber-bridge at TGR's Bridge Club in London and the Cavendish Bridge Club in New York. The tales of his money bridge adventures are well worth hearing!

Chris served as President of the United States Bridge Federation in 2004 and is presently 1st alternate for District 16 to the ACBL Board of Directors.

He has authored the teacher manual for 2/1 Texas Style and offers this class periodically at the Bridge Academy of North Dallas. Chris often serves as a volunteer lecturer at ACBL regional and national tournaments.

Jacoby 2NT

Donna Compton

A response of 2NT to an opening bid of one of a major suit shows 4-card support for opener's major and 13+ points. This bid applies only if responder is not a passed hand.

1♥ 2NT

Opener's Rebid to Jacoby 2NT

In response to responder's Jacoby 2NT bid, opener then describes the hand further:

1♥ 2NT
?

Balanced Hands

- With a minimum hand (13–14 points), sign off by jumping to game in the agreed suit.

1♥ 2NT
4♥

- With a medium hand (15–17 points), rebid 3NT.

1♥ 2NT
3NT

- With a maximum hand (18–21 points), rebid the major at the three level.

1♥ 2NT
3♥

Unbalanced Hands

- Bid the short suit at the three level.

1♥ 2NT
3♣

- Jump to the four level to show a good 5-card side suit.

1♥ 2NT
4♦

After hearing opener's description, responder can decide whether it is worthwhile to investigate for slam. If the hands fit poorly, responder signs off at the game level. If the hands fit well, responder moves toward slam—perhaps by cue bidding or using the Blackwood Convention.

Holdings in Opener's Shortness

If you have a good holding opposite your partner's singleton, cue bid your cheapest Ace or use Blackwood. Otherwise, sign off in game.

Good Holdings: A x x or x x x

Poor Holdings: K Q x or K Q J

Handling Interference

If the opponents overcall directly over the opening bid of 1♥ or 1♠, Jacoby 2NT no longer applies.

1♥ (2♦) ?

- Responder's 2NT bid is now a natural, invitational call, showing 11–12 points and some strength in the overcalled suit.
- A cue bid of the opponent's suit shows a fit with opener's suit and the strength for at least a limit raise.
- With a forcing raise, responder will make sure the partnership reaches game after hearing opener's rebid.

If an opponent interferes by bidding a suit after responder's Jacoby 2NT:

1♥ (Pass) 2NT (3♦)
?

Balanced Hands

- Double with a minimum hand (13–14 points).
- Bid 3NT with a medium (15–17 points) or maximum (18–21 points) hand with stoppers.

Unbalanced Hands

- Bid game with a semi-balanced hand.
- Pass with shortness in the overcalled suit.
- Bid a new suit to show shortness in that suit.

Jordan 2NT

After an opponent doubles partner's 1♥ or 1♠ opening, responder can use the Jordan 2NT Convention. A jump to 2NT shows 4-card support and the strength

for at least a limit raise. An immediate jump raise of opener's suit is preemptive, showing good trump support but a weak hand.

1♥ (X) 2NT = 11+ points with 3⁺-card support

1♥ (X) 3♥ = 6–10 points with 4-card support (preemptive)

Tomorrow: Splinter Bids

Stepping up from Average to a Good Bridge Player

Aside from having a burning desire to get better, here are habits I highly recommend the following habits:

1. Play with and against good players—Observe with an open and analytical mind. Don't be afraid to ask questions when appropriate.
2. Learn from experience—Nothing is more important than trial and error, but you must learn with an open mind and a strong ego. Learn mainly from your own mistakes. Be willing to be a fool and acknowledge your errors—bless them as a valuable opportunity to advance and move on!
3. Study—Many good books and magazines are available to absorb. Make use of them and don't turn the page until you have come up with an answer to the question presented.
4. Believe in your worth as a human being—Don't be intimidated by a more experienced player. In the scheme of things, is he or she a better person than you? Hell, no! Also along this same line, be selfish with your time and take as much time as you need and are allowed to solve your problem; you're entitled!
5. Be disciplined in your thought process—Don't "Triple W": Worry, Wonder, Wander. Think clearly and concisely. Mainly, master the art of counting points and distribution, the real hallmark of a great player!
6. Bid or play the best percentage action. For example, don't be overly influenced by a negative possibility:

"I'll go down six if the finesse loses."

Take the damn finesse if it's the percentage play to get you the best result—period!

7. Last but not least, be a good partner. Do this in two ways: (a) never look over your partner's shoulder and criticize and (b) always work on a definitive clear partnership understanding on defense and bidding. Work as a helpful and supportive partner and you will reap the rewards by the bushel in success and pleasure!

Smiley Cards

You may have noticed the yellow Smiley face cards in your bidding boxes. Use of these cards gives you an easy, non-confrontational way of letting your partner or an opponent know that his or her behavior is not conforming to Zero Tolerance.



If you feel the situation warrants, simply pull out the card and lay it on the table for a moment. If the behavior doesn't stop, **call the director**. Using the Smiley face card can be a good way to lessen the tension at the table.
