Splinter Bids

Splinters Defined

Splinter bids are special raises of partner's suit to show slam interest. In some cases, you can make slam on fewer than the normal 33 points when your hands "fit" together.

Splinter bids show the following:

- 4⁺-card support for partner
- A singleton or void in a side suit (the splinter suit)

A SPLINTER IS A DOUBLE JUMP IN A NEW SUIT.

Splinter bids may be used by responder or opener.

- Splinter bids by RESPONDER in support of opener's suit.
- 13–16 support points

Double Jump Exceptions

Jump past the 4-level!: A single jump bid by opener is a splinter bid if the double jump would take you higher than the four level. Since 3♦ would be a game force, you no longer need a strong jump shift bid. Therefore, the single jump becomes a splinter bid.

Jump-Shift Reverse: A single jump bid by opener is a splinter bid if it is a jump-shift reverse. Since 2♥ would be a reverse (and forcing), you no longer need a strong jump shift bid. Therefore, the single jump becomes a splinter bid.

Splintering with Singleton Aces and Kings—No, No!

DO NOT have a singleton Ace or King in your splinter suit. When you make a splinter bid, partner will devalue any high cards that he holds in your short suit (and upgrade high cards in other suits). If you have a King or Ace in the short suit, partner is going to misjudge the "working" cards in his hand.

Reevaluating Your Hand after a Splinter Bid

When partner makes a splinter bid, you must re-evaluate your hand taking into account where the “working” cards are located in your partner’s hand.

- Your hand gets better if you have little or no values in partner’s short suit. With little or no values in partner’s splinter bid, you can subtract 10 points from the 40 point deck and bid slams with only 27 points instead of 33 points.

Good Holdings in Partner’s Splinter Bid:

A 5 4 (3)
6 5 4 (3)
J 6 4 (3)

- Your hand gets worse if you have high cards in partner’s short suit. Disregard any King, Queen, or Jack in partner’s splinter bid and then decide whether to continue toward slam or sign off in game.

Opener’s Rebids after Responder Splinters

When partner makes a splinter bid, you know that he has 13–16 support points. You will need about 17+ points in your hand to make a slam.

- Make a slam try (cue bid) if your hand has improved and you have at least 15 points.
- If you have 18+ points, you should make a slam try even if your hand has not been improved by partner’s bid.

Responder’s Rebids after Opener Splinters

When partner splinters over your one-level response, you know that he has at least 19 support points, four trumps, and shortness in the splinter suit.

- Make a slam try if your hand has improved and you have at least 10 valuation points.

- If you have 13+ valuation points, you should make a slam try even if your hand has not been improved by partner's bid.

Continuing the Auction after a Splinter Bid

After re-evaluation, you must make a decision as to whether your hand is good enough for a slam try.

Sign-Off Bid: If you do not have enough to make a slam try that would take the auction past game, bid four of the agreed major.

Cue bid: Any suit other than the trump suit that you bid after a splinter is a cue bid. When you want to explore slam without committing yourself to Blackwood, a cue bid is a bid made to show a first or second round control in a suit.

Blackwood: You have first or second round control in all suits and are looking for the number of controls in your partner's hand.

Tips on Discarding

Proper discarding is one of the most important aspects of defensive play.

➤ One of the many important points to keep in mind when discarding is to try to maintain length parity with dummy unless your spot cards are insignificant or if partner is known to control the suit. Also, if declarer is known to have a 4-card suit, be careful about discarding from that suit if you also have four cards.

➤ When you have a choice of discarding from a suit you like and a suit you don't like, it is often best to signal negatively in the suit you don't like. This can be especially important when defending a notrump contract where the discard of a high card from a strong suit might cost a trick. For example, if you have a choice of discarding from ♥ 7 5 3 2 or ♣ A K 10 7 3, it's usually better to discard the heart 2 rather than the club 7. You may have five club tricks.

➤ Discard from a suit that declarer already knows about so that you avoid giving away additional information. If you open the bidding with 2♥, declarer knows you have a 6-card suit. A heart discard will not give declarer any new information.

➤ When discarding from an honor sequence, discard the highest card in the sequence—the one you would have led had you been on opening lead. For example, if you're discarding from ♣ Q J 10 9 8, discard the Queen. The discard of an honor shows you have the lower touching honors but no higher honor.

➤ Save at least one card in the suit partner has led if you have a potential entry in your hand.
