Don't Ever Give Up!

You get a club lead and East plays the Queen. Because this is matchpoints you can't afford to duck, so you play the club Ace. Of course you start playing diamonds but—doesn't this always seem to happen?—West shows out, meaning East has ♦ J 9 8 x. You continue with two more rounds of diamonds, West pitching spades on all three tricks.

This hand can be made with any defense, as long as your declarer play is good. How do you do it?

Your very first job is to think about the distribution: West has no diamonds and led a small club, which probably means he has 4-4-0-5 distribution and one or both of the missing club honors (the King and Jack). If West had a 5-card major, surely he would have led from that instead of a club. Eureka! West is squeezed at trick 2!

Think about West's dilemma and why any discard he makes gives you the contract, as long as you are on your toes and counting.

1. If West throws even one heart you have 9 tricks (1 spade, 4 hearts, 3 diamonds, and 1 club).

2. If West throws 3 spades you can endplay him by playing the spade Ace then the heart Ace, King, and Queen, throwing West in on the fourth heart.

West can cash his club King and Jack but then has to lead to your good club 10—again, you get 9 tricks (1 spade, 3 hearts, 3 diamonds, and 2 clubs).

3. If West ever throws a club you lead a fourth diamond. The opponents can cash a diamond and 3 clubs, but you still have 9 tricks (1 spade, 3 hearts, and 4 diamonds or 2 hearts and 5 diamonds depending on what you pitch from dummy, and 1 club).

A Lesson Well Learned

I just completed teaching a class on Defense at the Bridge House. Two of my students, Jim Gauntt and Bill Jones, recently demonstrated that they had done their homework. Unfortunately, the demonstration was against me.

The bidding was genuinely unusual but my partner declared 3♥ after Jim, sitting East, had shown length and strength in both minors. Below is the full hand:

Bill got the defense off to a good start by leading the club King, on which Jim played the 10. They were playing upside-down signals so a high card like the 10 asked for a shift, probably to diamonds. Bill knew Jim had values in diamonds but he also knew Jim had to be short in spades. Backing his intuition he shifted to the spade Ace and continued with a low spade. Declarer logically placed the

spade Queen with East and played dummy's King.

Ouch! Jim ruffed the spade King and continued with the club Ace and a small club. Bill ruffed the third club with the heart 9, cashed the spade Queen and shifted to a low diamond. Dummy played low and Jim won the diamond Queen and returned another club, which Bill ruffed with his heart Queen. Bill returned another diamond to Jim's diamond Ace.

We were down five, having lost the first nine tricks, before partner ever had a chance to get in.

I don't mean to imply that Bill and Jim would not have found this defense before taking my defense class, but the thought did give me some comfort. Luckily, though, they apparently skipped the class on penalty doubles.

Why Bridge is Better than Sex
